



Edward J. Trela

May 21, 1916 - January 10, 2013

Mr. Edward Joseph Trela, 96, of 40 Victory Terrace, Adams, died early Thursday morning, January 10, 2013, at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in Adams on May 21, 1916, a son of the late Franciszek and Aniela (Gora) Trela, and attended Adams schools.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the United States Army, until his Honorable Discharge in 1945.

Mr. Trela last worked as a supervisor at the former Arnold Print Works in Adams for 24 years, until retiring in 1981. Earlier, he had worked as a loom fixer at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and a member of the Mountain Club.

His wife, the former Jeannette Fillion, whom he married on May 11, 1940, died on February 12, 1969.

He is survived by a son, James Trela, and his wife, Carol, of Baldwin , Maryland;

His longtime companion, Felicia Clarke of Adams;
