Mrs. Elaine Hazel (Bell) Love, 84, of 7 Glendale Drive, Adams, died Thursday, December 6, 2012, at Baystate Medical Center in Springfield.

She was born in St. Stephen, New Brunswick, Canada, on February 20, 1928, a daughter of the late Roy and Emma Rhetta (McKay) Bell. She attended schools in Milltown, NB, and graduated from St. Stephen Business College on June 29, 1946.
