



Eleanor U. Morin

February 6, 1916 - September 23, 2009

Mrs. Eleanor Upton (Hathaway) Morin, 93, of 47 Pleasant St., Westford, MA, formerly a longtime resident of Cheshire, died peacefully on Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at the Westford House Nursing Home, Westford. She was born in Adams on February 6, 1916, a daughter of the late Arthur and Ella (Horn) Hathaway.

She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Morin worked for several years for the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co., Adams, and the former England Brothers, Pittsfield. She also aided the community through her work as a Red Cross Swim Instructor.

While in Cheshire she was a member of the Cheshire Baptist Church. She was a member of the Girl's Club in Pittsfield, and the Cheshire Historical Society.

Mrs. Morin moved to Westford with her husband to live with their loving daughter and son-in-law Nancy and Gregory Wadleigh, where she enjoyed reading, nature and telling tales about the Berkshires.

Her husband, Clifford T. Morin, whom she married on November 9, 1941, died on March 10, 2005.
