



## Elizabeth T. Godek

January 20, 1918 - April 5, 2013

Mrs. Elizabeth "Betty" Theresa (Wojtaszek) Godek, 95, of 2 Manners Ave., Adams, died peacefully on Friday, April 5, 2013, at her home.

She was born in Adams on January 20, 1918, a daughter of the late John and Zofia (Strzepek) Wojtaszek. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School. She then went on to receive her degree as a Registered Nurse from the former Henry W. Bishop 3rd Memorial School of Nursing in Pittsfield in 1938.

Mrs. Godek last worked as a registered nurse for the Town of Adams in St. Stanislaus Kostka School and the former Notre Dame Elementary School. Earlier she had worked at the former W.B. Plunkett Memorial Hospital, Adams. In 1972, Mrs. Godek was given a commendation from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Health for her professional response when the Town of Adams experienced a sharp uprise in the case-rate of Tuberculosis during 1970.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.

Her husband, A. Edward Godek, whom she married on April 21, 1941, died on January 21, 1995.
