February 2, 1933 - January 16, 2011

Mr. Elzear V. "Al" Vincelette, 77, of 247 Wells Avenue, North Adams, died on Sunday, January 16, 2011, at North Adams Commons, after a short battle with Lewy Body Dementia with his family at his side. He had resided at the nursing home for the past week.
