



## Emile Satko

Mr. Emile John Satko, 86, of 22 Thompson St. Adams, MA, died Monday evening at his home.

He was born in Adams on April 11, 1919, a son of the late Jozef and Tekla (Grzebien) Satko. He attended Adams schools, graduated from the former Adams High School in 1937. He then graduated from the Coyne Electrical School in Chicago in 1938.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the 237th Signal Service Company of the US Army in the European Theater from 1942 until his Honorable Discharge in 1945.

Mr. Satko worked as a winder in the Power Transformer division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 41 years, until retiring in January of 1981.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, the former Mary A. Mroz, whom he married on July 30, 1949;
