



Emilie Czelusniak

November 5, 1917 - January 20, 2007

Mrs. Emilie (Wanat) Czelusniak, 89, of 3 Myrtle St. Adams, died early Saturday morning at Northwestern Medical Center in St. Albans, Vermont. She was born in Adams on November 5, 1917, a daughter of the late Joseph and Aniela (Furtek) Wanat. She moved to Cheshire as a child, and attended Cheshire schools, returning to Adams after her marriage.

Mrs. Czelusniak last worked in the Ordnance division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 20 years, until retiring in 1980.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of Group 776 of the Polish Women's Alliance of America and St. Michael's Society.

She is survived by her husband, Thadeus Czelusniak, whom she married on November 3, 1945;
