Mrs. Emily A. (Szukala) Sadlowski, 89, formerly of 9 Simon Ave. Adams, died Thursday evening, March 29, 2012, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on June 13, 1922, a daughter of the late John and Mary (Zeman) Szukala, and attended Adams schools.
