Mark Edwin Ogert, 51, of North Adams passed away on Saturday, January 6, 2018 at his home surrounded by his family and friends after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Mark was born in North Adams on December 16, 1966, son of Sandra J. (Maynard) Singer and the late Sidney E. Ogert. Mark attended public schools in North Adams and graduated from Charles H. McCann Technical High School where he earned an education in Metal Fabrication.

Prior to his employment with Lenco, he worked at Bennington Iron Works for 23 years. Mark also served in the United States Navy and was medically discharge after finishing boot camp.
