



Ernest N. Lussier

November 17, 1930 - June 9, 2013

Mr. Ernest Norman "Babe" Lussier, 82, of 340 Wells Ave. Clarksburg, died early Sunday morning, June 9, 2013, at North Adams Commons.

He was born in North Adams on November 17, 1930, a son of the late Columban "Jack" and Bertha (Lussier) Lussier, and attended North Adams schools.

He had served with the Massachusetts Army National Guard for many years. Mr. Lussier worked as a service technician and, later, as foreman of the road crew, for the Berkshire Gas Co., until retiring in 1992 after 35 years of service. He was a communicant of St. Elizabeth of Hungary Church, North Adams, and was a member of the North Adams Lodge of Elks, Frank R. Stiles Post 125 American Legion, and AMVETS. He enjoyed golfing and playing cribbage.

He is survived by his wife of 63 years, the former Doris J. Daigneault, whom he married on October 28, 1950;
