



Felicia B. Skowronski

January 3, 1922 - May 18, 2013

Mrs. Felicia B. (Leja) Skowronski, 91, of 18 Siara St. Adams, died peacefully early Saturday morning, May 18, 2013, at her daughter's home.

She was born in Adams on January 3, 1922, a daughter of the late John and Mary (Banas) Leja. She attended St. Stanislaus Elementary School, Adams, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1940.

Mrs. Skowronski last worked at the former Waverly Fabrics in Adams for 14 years, until retiring in 1984. Earlier, she had worked at the former W.T. Grant Store and the former Pociask Clothing Store in Adams, and the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams.
