



## Felix A. Scieszka, Jr.

November 20, 1918 - November 22, 2011

Mr. Felix Alexander Scieszka, Jr., 93, of 42 Melrose St., Adams, died on Tuesday, November 22, 2011 at his home.

He was born in Adams on November 20, 1918, a son of the late Felix and Aniela (Grzebien) Scieszka. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Scieszka was a veteran of World War II, the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War, having served for 30 years with the Army Air Corps and the United States Air Force, during which time he flew 64 missions. He had served in the European and Pacific theaters and ultimately retired as a Technical Sergeant in 1975.

Mr. Scieszka worked for many years in the Power Transformer Division of General Electric Co., Pittsfield.

He was a communicant of the former St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a member of Adams Post 160 American Legion and a life member of the Maple Grove Civic Club.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, the former Giuseppa "Pena" Zirolli, whom he married on July 4, 1955;
