Mr. Ferdinand J. "Fred" Diaferio, Jr., 65, of Ewing, New Jersey, died Tuesday afternoon, October 2, 2012, at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. He was the husband of Sandra E. (Kowalski) Diaferio, a native of Adams.
