Mrs. Florence J. (Remian) Komorek, 92, of 95 East Ave., North Adams, died peacefully on Wednesday morning, August 20, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield, surrounded by her family.

She was born in Southbridge, MA on August 3, 1921, a daughter of the late Vincent and Mary (Boduch) Remian. She attended Southbridge schools, and graduated from Mary Wells High School. She came to North Adams in 1957.

Mrs. Komorek was primarily a homemaker for most of her life.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She enjoyed cooking and baking, and was a fan of the Boston Red Sox and Boston Celtics.

Her husband, Dr. John J. Komorek, a longtime educator at the former North Adams State College, whom she married on August 3, 1947, died on November 28, 1984.
