



Mrs. Florence D. Millette

August 26, 1918 - August 6, 2015

Mrs. Florence D. (Johnson) Millette, 96, of 23 Notch Rd. Adams, died Thursday afternoon, August 6, 2015, at Craneville Place in Dalton.

She was born in Adams on August 26, 1918, a daughter of the late William and Dora (Noel) Johnson. She attended the former Notre Dame Elementary School and the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Millette worked at the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams for 30 years, until retiring. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.

She was a communicant of Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Church, Adams, and was a member of the Adams Senior Citizens. She enjoyed reading, puzzles, crafts, sewing, and traveling to Florida.
