September 6, 1919 - April 24, 2008

Mrs. Florence Mary (Schneider) Nimmons, 88, of 4 Columbia St. Adams, died Thursday morning, April 24, 2008 at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on September 6, 1919, daughter of the late Max Schneider and Emma (Baker) Schneider Bond. She attended Adams schools. Mrs. Nimmons last worked as a clerk at the former Adams Outlet Store in Adams, retiring when it closed. Earlier, she had worked for many years at the former Shea's Clothing Store in Adams.

She was a communicant of the Parish of Notre Dame & St. Thomas Aquinas, Adams. She was a former member of the Adams Senior Citizens and the Senior Hoofers Walking Club.

She was accomplished in needlework, and made many items knitting, crocheting, embroidering and tatting. She also enjoyed walking, reading, music and singing.

Her husband, Samuel R. Nimmons, whom she married on October 6, 1943, died on December 8, 1984.
