



## Frances K. Kondel

August 16, 1920 - July 12, 2011

Frances Katherine (Koziol) Kondel, 91, wife of the late John S. Kondel, and much loved mother of Frances and Katherine passed very peacefully into the afterlife at Sweet Brook of Williamstown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on Tuesday, July 12, 2011.

Frances was born in Adams on August 16, 1920, the daughter of John and Sofia (Fafara) Koziol. She attended St. Stanislaus Kostka School and was a 1939 graduate of the former Adams Memorial High School.

Mrs. Kondel married John Stanley Kondel on July 3, 1939 in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church in Adams, and she settled at 6 Lincoln St., where they shared 62 years of marriage and raised their three children.
