



## Frances J. Zabek

March 7, 1923 - November 9, 2007

Mrs. Frances J. (Czechowski) Zabek, 84, formerly of 3 Myrtle St. Adams, died peacefully on Friday evening, November 9, 2007, at Island Terrace Nursing Home in Lakeville, MA, with her family at her side.
