Mrs. Frances Josephine (Sakowski) Zwiercan, 85, of Millhouse Apartments, 75 Commercial St. Adams, died Thursday morning at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on September 16, 1919, a daughter of the late Joseph and Laura (Lemanski) Sakowski. She lived in Hinsdale as a child, and attended Dalton schools. She lived in Savoy for many years, and moved to Adams six years ago.

Mrs. Zwiercan last worked at Crane & Co. in Dalton for 8 years, retiring 20 years ago. Earlier, she worked as a domestic and cook for several local families, and also worked as a nurse's aide for several years.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She enjoyed tatting, knitting, crocheting and cooking. She was strongly devoted to her faith.

Her husband, John H. Zwiercan, whom she married July 21, 1945, died on February 17, 1992.
