



## Mr. Francis T. Sobon

February 26, 1939 - October 7, 2015

Mr. Francis T. Sobon, 76, of 21 ½ Hoosac St. Adams, died Wednesday evening, October 7, 2015, at Williamstown Commons after a brief illness. He was born in Adams on February 26, 1939, a son of the late Peter and Veronica (Mikuszewski) Sobon. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School.

He was a Veteran of the Vietnam era, serving with the US Army until his Honorable Discharge in 1963. Mr. Sobon worked as a forklift operator in the Power Transformer division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield until retiring. Through the years, he enjoyed playing for Krutiak Construction's softball team, bowling at the Saints Hall and especially golfing at Forest Park Country Club and Stamford Valley Golf Course.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a member of Adams Post 160 American Legion, the Adams Lodge of Elks, the Forest Park Country Club and the Maple Grove Civic Club, all in Adams.
