



Mr. Frank B. Wysocki

August 4, 1928 - May 5, 2014

Mr. Frank B. Wysocki, 85, of 3 Iroquois Drive, North Adams, died early Monday morning, May 5, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. He was born in Adams on August 4, 1928, a son of the late Thomas and Frances (Hejnar) Wysocki. He attended St. Stanislaus Elementary School, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1946. Frank worked as a welder in the tank shop at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, until retiring after 43 years of service.

He had served with Company M of the Massachusetts Army National Guard for 20 years.

He was a communicant of the Parish of Saint John Paul II, Adams, and a former communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church. He was a member of the Northern Berkshire Retired Men's Club, and was a member of their bowling and golfing leagues. He was also a member of the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs, and a former member of the Adams Turners. He enjoyed sports, bowling, golfing and playing cards, especially cribbage. He was an avid fan of the Boston Red Sox.

He and his wife, the former Carol L. Mirke, were married on February 27, 1954 in the former St. Thomas Aquinas Church, Adams, by the late Rev. James A. Lahey.

Besides his wife, he is survived by 3 daughters, Susan Baker and her husband, Ron, of North Adams;
