C. Fred Dubis, 94, Of 6 Dubis St. Adams, died Thursday afternoon, February 5th, at St. Francis Hospital in Hartford, CT.

He was born in Adams on October 25, 1914, a son of the late Anthony and Katherine (Ptak) Dubis, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Dubis worked as a millwright in the Power Transformer division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 35 years, until retiring January 1, 1977.

He was a member of the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs.

His wife, the former Wanda Mazinski, whom he married on August 22, 1941, died on February 12, 1991.

He was predeceased by 7 brothers and 1 sister.
