“ In the logical order of things most of us know our siblings longer than we will know anyone. I have known my sister Gail for over 65 years. We all know how much goodness she has brought into so many lives, but from the very day she was born she made life better for me. I was staying at my grandmother Peat's house while our mother was giving birth to my baby sister. On the day Gail was born, Mim awakened me and told me that I now had a new baby sister. Breakfast started out as usual but as Mim went to her refrigerator she took out a dish of my favorite dessert; chocolate pudding and placed it in front of me declaring that “In honor of your sister's birth you get to have chocolate pudding for breakfast.” Memories of our house on Cherry Street flood my mind as I recall my sister as a child. Gail had starred as nun in a play at Notre Dame grammar school. My mother had sewn a nun's habit complete with veil and oversized rosary beads that Gail would wear as she converted her tiny bedroom into a classroom where she taught any hapless neighborhood kids she could cajole into acting as her pupils. She had asked me to play one of her students, but I always declined. I suspect she would have used me as a bad example to the rest of her class and meted out some form of corporal punishment that I probably would have deserved. But Gail did become a teacher after all. She taught us all life lessons in love, caring and compassion. She taught by example, by living a life of unselfish giving to others. To her family, and to her friends, and to all who were lucky enough to have known her Gail was a constant source of support and affection. At some point in remarks such as these it is invariably said that the deceased has indeed gone to a better place. Not so with my sister Gail, she has gone to make it a better place! I have always believed that our deceased loved ones comfort, protect and help us in more ways than they could when they were here on earth. During the civil war, Major Sullivan Ballou wrote his wife a letter on July 14th 1861, in it he said: “If I should fall in battle, know that my last thoughts were of you. If the dead can come back to earth and flit unseen around those they love, I shall always be with you, in the brightest day and the darkest night, always. When the soft breeze fans your cheek, it shall be my breath, or the cool air soothe your throbbing temple it shall be my spirit passing by. Do not mourn me dead, think I am gone, and wait for me, for we shall meet again.” Sullivan Ballou was killed one week later at the first battle of Bull Run. And so my sister is in that place now made better by her presence there. From where she can continue to make earth a better place for all of us. A place where a four year old boy can even have chocolate pudding for breakfast.
