



Gladys S. Alibozek

May 19, 1914 - September 27, 2007

Mrs. Gladys Monica (Salisz) Alibozek, 93, of 49 North Summer St., Adams, died on Thursday September 27, 2007, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on May 19, 1914, a daughter of the late Mikolaj and Zofia (Juras) Salisz. She attended schools in Adams, including St. Stanislaus Elementary School and the former Adams High School.
