Mrs. Gladys A. (Biros) Czubryt, 98, of Adams, died Friday evening, June 14, 2024 at Kimball Farms Nursing Care Center in Lenox. She was born in Adams on September 18, 1925, a daughter of the late Peter and Mary (Tomaszewski) Biros and attended Adams schools. Gladys last worked in the cut order department at the former Waverly Fabrics in Adams until retiring. Earlier, she had worked at the former Wall Streeter Shoe Co. in North Adams and the former Adams Print Works in Adams.
