



## Gladys Trzcinski

Mrs. Gladys Josephine (Mikuszewski) Trzcinski, 86, of 45 Highland St. West Hartford, Connecticut, a native of Adams, died Friday morning at Hughes Health & Rehabilitation Center in West Hartford. Death followed a brief illness. She was born in Adams on November 8, 1919, a daughter of the late Szymon and Tekla (Malek) Mikuszewski, and attended St. Stanislaus Elementary School in Adams. She had lived in West Hartford for the past 55 years.

Mrs. Trzcinski worked briefly for Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams, MA. After moving to Connecticut, she worked at Pratt & Whitney/United Technologies for many years, until retiring 25 years ago.
