



Mrs. Gladys F., Wilk

February 7, 1918 - December 13, 2015

Mrs. Gladys F. (Stefanik) Wilk, 97, of 135 East Road, Adams, died Sunday evening, December 13, 2015, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on February 7, 1918, daughter of the late Andrew and Anna (Glod) Stefanik, and grew up in Cheshire. She attended schools in Cheshire and Adams, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1938.

Mrs. Wilk worked at the former Wall Streeter Shoe Co. in North Adams for many years, until the factory closed. She then worked at North Adams Regional Hospital for eight years, and last worked at The Orchards Hotel in Williamstown for several years until retiring.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a longtime member of Court Sancta Regina # 904 of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas.

She loved her home, small animals and traveling.

Her husband, Henry A. Wilk, whom she married on October 7, 1944, died on May 30, 2009.

She is survived by her son, Daniel H. Wilk, with whom she made her home; 3 Godchildren, Stanley Stefanik of Dundee, NY; Susan Stefanik Corah of Glenville, NY and Thomas Stefanik of Adams; as well as many nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews.

She was predeceased by her daughter, Barbara Wilk Rougeau, in 1980; and by 3 brothers, Michael, Edward and Theodore Stefanik.

The funeral will be held on Thursday, December 17th, at 10:00 AM in the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams.
