



## Guy R. Pelletier

August 31, 1933 - March 9, 2011

Mr. Guy Raymond Pelletier, 77, of 47 Bellevue Avenue, Adams, died on Wednesday, March 9, 2011 at his home, surrounded by his family.

He was born in Adams on August 31, 1933, a son of the late Philippe and Lucina (Caron) Pelletier. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Pelletier was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, having served with the United States Marine Corps until receiving his honorable discharge on August 4, 1955.

Following his discharge from the Marines, Mr. Pelletier attended DeVry Technical School in Chicago for one year and then returned to Adams to go to work as a technician for General Electric Co., Pittsfield until retiring in 1985. He was a communicant of the Parish of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, the Adams Post 160 American Legion, the Stamford Country Club, the Mt. Greylock Bowling League, the GE Pensioners Club, and a former member of the Greylock Archery Club. When his children were small he had coached for the Adams Little League. He enjoyed gardening and traveling.

He is survived by his wife 54 years, the former Dorothy J. Zieba, whom he married on June 23, 1956;
