



## Harold V. Girard

June 20, 1924 - May 18, 2012

Mr. Harold V. Girard, 87, of 5 Pinnacle Lane, Adams, died on Friday, May 18, 2012 at his home.

He was born in Lanesboro on June 20, 1924, a son of the late Herbert and Mary (Langer) Girard.

Mr. Girard was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Navy until receiving his Honorable Discharge as Signalman Third Class on January 15, 1946.

Mr. Girard worked for many years as a master welder in the Ordnance Division of General Electric Co., Pittsfield until retiring in 1984. He had also been a carpenter by trade, helping to build several homes in the community. He was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul the Great, Adams. He was a member of the Adams Post 160 American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars in Massachusetts and Florida, a member of the Cheshire Rod & Gun Club and Past President and Life Member of the Mountain Club, Adams. He was an avid hunter and fisherman.

He is survived by his wife of 65 years, the former B. Isabelle Langlois, whom he married on October 26, 1946;
