



## Helen C. Armata

December 23, 1918 - February 5, 2007

Mrs. Helen Cecilia (Gwozdz) Armata, 88, of 59 East St., Adams, died Monday February 5, 2007, at the North Adams Regional Hospital. Death followed a long illness.

She was born in Adams on December 23, 1918, a daughter of the late Piotr and Bronislawa (Banas) Gwozdz.

She attended schools in Adams, including St. Stanislaus Kostka School and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1934. She then received her Bachelor of Science in Education from the former North Adams State College in 1939.

Mrs. Armata was an elementary school teacher in the Adams-Cheshire Regional School District in the 1940's and mid 1960's, and specialized in special needs students in the 1970's, until her retirement in 1979.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She was also a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality, the St. Cecilia's Choir, the TMTM club, and the NEA Teachers Association. She was an avid reader and loved dancing and music. She had been involved in many theatrical productions at college and in her church.

She is survived by her husband Roman J. Armata whom she married on April 23, 1946. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary this past spring.
