Mrs. Helen Frances (Kurpaska) Mazzoli, R.N., 77, of 34 First St. Adams, died Saturday morning at her home.

She was born in Adams on August 6, 1927, a daughter of the late Peter and Helen (Szpila) Kurpaska, and graduated from St. Stanislaus Elementary School, and the former Adams High School in 1945. She graduated from the Holyoke Hospital School of Nursing as a Registered Nurse in 1948.
