



## Mrs. Helen K. Szufnarowski

February 27, 1927 - October 5, 2013

Mrs. Helen K. (Dabrowski) Szufnarowski, 86, of 10 Haggerty St. Adams, died Saturday afternoon, October 5th, 2013, at Craneville Place in Dalton.

She was born in Adams on February 27, 1927, a daughter of the late Joseph and Honorata (Ciejka) Dabrowski. She attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Szufnarowski last worked as an administrative assistant for the Adams-Cheshire Regional School District. Earlier, she had worked in the same capacity for General Electric Co., C.H. McCann Technical High School, Dr. Francis Gospodarek and North Adams Regional Hospital.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality, Forest Park Country Club, and the YMCA in North Adams.

She enjoyed gardening, sewing, traveling and playing cards. She was a fan of the Boston Red Sox and was a fabulous cook.

Her husband, Fredrick S. Szufnarowski, whom she married on June 12, 1948, died on March 13, 1998.

She is survived by a son, Frederick J. Szufnarowski of Essex, CT; a daughter, Linda Belanger and her husband, Tyrone, of Lanesborough; 2 sisters, Celia Danecki and Janet Wilk, both of Adams; 5 Grandchildren, and many nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews. She was predeceased by 3 brothers, Walter, Stephen and John Dabrowski; and by a sister, Phyllis Blazejewski.
