



Henry Neidzwiecki

April 5, 1922 - August 27, 2009

Mr. Henry Neidzwiecki, 87, of 17 Apache Drive, North Adams, died on Thursday, August 27, 2009, at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in North Adams on April 5, 1922, a son of the late John and Eleanora (Kubet) Niedzwiecki. He attended schools in North Adams.

Mr. Neidzwiecki was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Army until his Honorable Discharge in 1945.

Mr. Neidzwiecki had worked for General Electric Co., Pittsfield, until starting his own business, Hank's Painting and Papering. He started the business in North Adams, then moved with his family to Cape Cod where he continued to work until his retirement. He moved back to North Adams in 2001.

He was a member of the former St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. While on the Cape he was a member of the American Veterans.

His wife, the former Normagene Sutton, whom he married on April 26, 1947, died on November 1, 2000.
