August 13, 1928 - July 24, 2005

Mr. Henry Stanislaus Soha, 76, of 4 Columbia St. Adams, died Sunday afternoon at his home.

He was born in Clarksburg, MA on August 13, 1928, a son of the late Andrew and Victoria (Obara) Soha. He moved to Adams as a child with his family, and attended Adams schools, including St. Stanislaus Kostka School.

Mr. Soha was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving with the US Army for 3 years until his honorable discharge as a Corporal.
