Mr. Henry Arthur Wilk, 94, of 135 East Road, Adams, died Saturday evening, May 30th, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

He was born in Adams on September 24, 1914, a son of the late Justyn and Aniela (Kosierowska) Wilk, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Wilk last worked for the former Adams Super Market Corp. in Adams for 20 years, until his retirement. Earlier, he had worked at the former Brightwater Paper Co. in Adams for many years.

He had been a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish in Adams. He was a longtime member of the Polish National Alliance.

Mr. Wilk enjoyed the outdoors, and raised small animals as a hobby. In his younger days, he raised as many as 100 white Holland turkeys at a time at his small farm.

He is survived by his wife of 64 years, the former Gladys F. Stefanik, whom he married on October 7, 1944;

1 brother, Arthur Wilk of Williamstown;

1 sister, Doree Marceau of North Adams; and several nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.

His daughter, Barbara Wilk-Rougeau, died on January 23, 1980. He was predeceased by 5 brothers, John, Theodore, Justyn, Frank and Stanley Wilk, and by a 2 sisters, Sophie George and Mildred Dean.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, June 3rd, at 10:30 AM in the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams.

Rev. Daniel J. Boyle, Pastor of the Parish of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams, will officiate. Burial will follow in St. Stanislaus Kostka Cemetery, Adams.
