Mrs. Hilda Elizabeth (Wilson) LeBlond, 95, of 207 East Road, Adams, died on Saturday, June 9, 2012 at Williamstown Commons.

She was born on North Adams on January 11, 1917, a daughter of the late Ralph England and Emma (Birch) Wilson England. She attended schools in North Adams.
