



## Mrs. Isabelle M. Ponti

June 6, 1928 - March 4, 2016

Mrs. Isabelle Mary (Collette) Ponti, 87, formerly of 85 Eagle St. North Adams, died Friday morning, March 4, 2016, at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in North Adams on June 6, 1928, a daughter of the late J. Alfred and Margaret (Lebert) Collette, and attended North Adams schools.
