Mr. E. James " Jimmy" Albozek, 90, of 22 East Road, Adams, died Friday evening, June 9, 2006, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Adams on December 18, 1915, a son of the late Frank and Aniela (Struzik) Albozek, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Albozek last worked at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, until retiring in 1977 after 34 years of service. Earlier, he had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams, and the former U.S. Gypsum Co. in Cheshire.
