Jane Rose (Pikul) Nevares, 75, of Adams, died peacefully on Sunday, October 6, 2024, at her home with her sister and brother by her side.

She was born in Adams on August 10, 1949, a daughter of the late Peter and Frances (Kozik) Pikul. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams Memorial High School.

Following her graduation, Jane attended the Hartford Airline Personnel School and started her career working as an agent for United Airlines in New York City then in Hawaii.
