Janet P. (Skrocki) Sikora, formerly of Richmond Lane, Adams, died on March 5, 2011, in Alexandria, Virginia. She was 94.

Mrs. Sikora, daughter of the late Teofil and Julianna (Doliva) Skrocki, was born in Adams on April 27, 1916. She attended schools and lived most of her life in Adams. For the past six years she resided with her children in Springfield, Virginia, and Bethesda, Maryland.
