July 26, 1919 - November 16, 2007

Miss Jessie Frances Zala, 88, of 42 East Hoosac St. Adams, died Friday evening, November 16, 2007, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. She was born in Adams on July 26, 1919, the daughter of the late John and Margaret (Kuza) Zala. She attended Adams schools, including the former Adams High School.

Miss Zala worked in the Power Transformer division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, until retiring in 1984. Earlier, she had worked at the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams and the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of its St. Cecelia's Choir. She was a member and Vice-President of the St. Stanislaus Rosary Sodality. She was also a member of St. Michael's Society, the General Electric Pensioner's Club and was a member and past treasurer of the former TMTM Club.

She is survived by several cousins, including F. Michael Kuza of Adams; C. Richard Kuza and his wife, Gosia, of Adams; and Cynthia Dominick, Timothy and Elizabeth Dominick, Megan and Julie Dominick, all of Chicopee, MA.
