



## Joan Hyndman

Mrs. Joan Francis ( Horn ) Hyndman, 74, of 281 West Road, Adams, died early Thursday, October 21, 2004, at Craneville Place in Dalton, with her family at her side. Death followed a long , courageous battle with diabetes. She was born in Adams on June 6, 1930, a daughter of the late Joseph and Viola (Taft) Horn. She attended Adams schools and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1948. She attended Berkshire Community College in Pittsfield to complete class work in computer technology.

Mrs. Hyndman had founded and operated her own business, The Candle Shop, with her sister, Beverly, for several years.
