



## Mrs. Joan D. Jozefiak

June 19, 1932 - May 13, 2014

Mrs. Joan D. (Strzepek) Jozefiak, 81, of 3 Myrtle St. Adams, died early Tuesday morning, May 13, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. She was born in Adams on June 19, 1932, a daughter of the late Alec and Sophie (Rymarski) Strzepek. She attended Adams schools, including St. Stanislaus Kostka School, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1949.

Mrs. Jozefiak worked as a receptionist for Mid Town Tax Service in Adams for several years. Earlier, she had worked at the former Waverly Fabrics in Adams, and had also volunteered in the Library at St. Stanislaus Kostka School in Adams.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of St. Michael's Society, and the Adams High Class of 1949 Reunion Committee.

She enjoyed spending much of her time with her grandchildren.

Her husband, Casimer "Cider" Jozefiak, whom she married on February 3, 1951, died on April 29, 1983.
