



Joan Bejgrowicz, R.N.

Miss Joan Bejgrowicz, RN, 68, of 6 Weber St. Adams, died Wednesday, January 6, 2010, at her home.

She was born in Adams on May 6, 1941, the daughter of John and Helen (Jasinski) Bejgrowicz. She attended Adams schools, and was a graduate of the former St. Luke's School of Nursing in Pittsfield. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Boston College.

Miss Bejgrowicz was a registered Nurse, working in the Critical Care Unit of North Adams Regional Hospital for many years, until retiring in 1999. Since then, she had worked at the Wal-Mart store in North Adams.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, where she was a faithful participant in the vigil and appeal to keep the church open. She was also a member of several professional nursing societies.

She is survived by her brother, Peter Bejgrowicz, of Adams, and several aunts, uncles and cousins.
