Mrs. Joanne P. (Tassone) Trimarchi, 75, formerly of Adams, died Thursday evening, March 16, 2017, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on April 6, 1941, the daughter of the late Angelo and Winifred (Edwards) Tassone. She attended local schools, and graduated from the former St. Joseph's High School in North Adams. She lived in North Adams for many years before moving to Adams several years ago.
