Mr. John Joseph Biros, 87, of 9 Richmond Lane, Adams, died Friday evening at his home. He was born in Warren, R.I. on April 11, 1918, son of the late Peter and Albina (Ciszek) Biros, and Mary Biros, who raised him after his first mother died when he was 3. He attended schools in Adams.
