



## John Czubryt

Mr. John Stanley Czubryt, 87, of 20 Victory St. Adams, died Tuesday morning, May 5th, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

He was born in Adams on Sept. 25, 1921, a son of the late Stanley and Julia (Ciulonka) Czubryt, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Czubryt was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Army in the 503rd Parachute Infantry Regiment in the Pacific Theater. He was Honorably Discharged in 1945.

Mr. Czubryt last worked for the Adams Highway Department for 20 years, until retiring in 1983. Earlier, he had worked for the former General Cable Co. in Williamstown.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish, Adams. He was a member and former trustee of the Polish National Alliance in Adams.

He enjoyed fishing, mushrooming and Polka music.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, the former Gladys A. Biros, whom he married on October 4, 1947;

He was predeceased by 5 brothers, Stephen, Stanley, William, Joseph and
