



John W. Dabrowski, Sr.

November 17, 1922 - August 31, 2012

Mr. John W. Dabrowski, Sr., 89, of 117 Orchard St., Adams, died on Friday, August 31, 2012, at Craneville Place in Dalton.

He was born in Adams on November 17, 1922, a son of the late Joseph and Honorata (Ciejka) Dabrowski. He attended schools in Adams, including St. Stanislaus Elementary and graduated from the former Adams High School. Mr. Dabrowski was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Marine Corps and a radio repairman and operator and had participated in action against the enemy until July 4, 1945 in the Southern Phillipine Islands. He was transferred to China and was Honorably discharged on May 22, 1946.

Mr. Dabrowski worked for many years as a machinist in the Naval Ordnance division of General Electric Co., Pittsfield until retiring in 1984.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a past member of the Retired Men's Golf League at Stamford Country Club and the Retired Men's Bowling League at Mt. Greylock Bowl, North Adams.

His wife, the former Theresa Zappone, whom he married on October 16, 1954, died on August 6, 2010.
