



## John J. Kondej

October 4, 1943 - February 28, 2009

Mr. John James Kondej, 65, of 4 Tower Ave., Adams, died on Saturday February 28, 2009, at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Adams on October 4, 1943, a son of the late Walter and Katherine (Blazejewski) Kondej. He attended schools in Adams and North Adams, including St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School, and he graduated from the former St. Joseph's High School, North Adams, with the class of 1961.

Mr. Kondej last worked for Crane & Company, Dalton, from 1993 until his retirement in 2005. He had also worked for General Electric Co., Pittsfield, from 1966 to 1992, and the former Sprague Electric Co., North Adams from 1961 to 1966.

He was a communicant of the former St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish, Adams, where he served as an usher, and then continued at the Parish of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams. He was a member of the Adams Lions Club, Adams Post 160 American Legion, and the Forest Park Country Club, Adams. He enjoyed playing golf and pitch, and gardening. He was an avid New York Yankee and Giants fan.

He is survived by his wife the former Jean M. Ciuk, whom he married on July 26, 1969;
