Mr. John F. Kopec, 95, formerly of 9 Baskin Lane, Adams, died Wednesday, June 6, 2012, at Halcyon Hospice in Atlanta, Georgia.

He was born in Adams on November 1, 1916, a son of the late Tytus and Anastasia (Wlodyka) Kopec, and attended Adams schools. He graduated in 1935 from the former Adams High School, where he was Captain of the State Champion Basketball team.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Navy in the Pacific Theater, until his Honorable Discharge in 1945.

Mr. Kopec last worked as a letter carrier for the US Postal service in Adams for 25 years, until retiring in 1981.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of the St. Stanislaus Kostka Society. An avid golfer, he was a member of Forest Park Country Club in Adams.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years, the former Helen S. Meczywor, whom he married on April 7, 1945;
